Westport House & Grounds: Ireland's Most Beautiful Historic Home

Discover the story behind Ireland's most beautiful historic house and the family who have survived alongside it. The Browne family built the original house in 1730 on the ruins of Grace O'Malley, the Pirate Queen's, 16th century castle. This same Pirate Queen is the 14th great grand-mother of Sheelyn and Karen Browne who are running the estate today. They have certainly inherited her determination in ensuring that one of Ireland's favourite heritage attractions remains open to visitors to enjoy. With over 30 rooms on show, 5 permanent exhibitions and thousands of pieces of original family artwork, artefacts and architecture, a visit to Westport is not complete without seeing Westport House. You'll be surprised at what you'll learn about this family's contribution to local - and global - history as well as their development of the house, estate and town. Westport House is open daily from 10am from March 1st to early November.

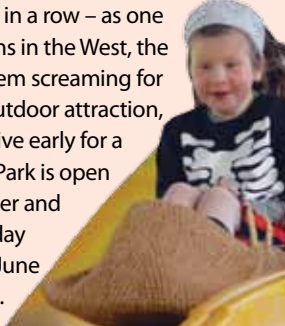
Pirate Adventure Park: Award-Winning Family Visitor Attraction
